## **Project Grow 2012 Plant Sale Pre-order Instructions**

Please read and follow all these instructions. We are not a professional mail order outfit. All our work is done by volunteers and uniformity in handling the orders and the orders themselves is essential.

1. ***Please use the first two pages of this form for your order.***
2. Select the plants you would like. To order a particular variety, enter the number of plants of the variety desired in the third column and the price for the plants in the fourth column (price = number of plants x \$3).
3. If you would like to also get a Project Grow mug, they are \$5 each and in the last row.
4. When finished, total the number of plants and the prices at the end of each column, and then total the columns as a Grand Total.
5. Mail the order form with a check for the Grand Total payable to "Project Grow". Mail the completed order and check to:

6. We must receive your order by April 21<sup>st</sup>.
7. Pick up your order on Saturday May 5<sup>th</sup> or Sunday May 6<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 1pm at 1518 Shadford in Ann Arbor. These are the only two days orders may be picked up.

If any of these restrictions pose a problem, we encourage you to attend our plant sale instead. The sale is Saturday May 12<sup>th</sup> and Saturday May 19<sup>th</sup> from 8am-2pm in front of People's Food Co-op on Fourth Avenue.
